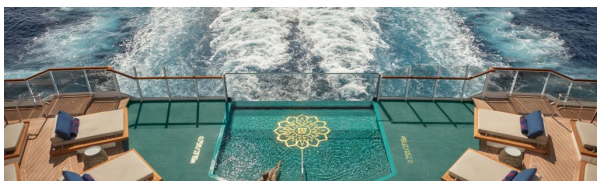

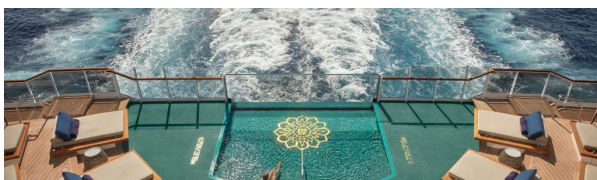

5 Gravity Defying Funchal

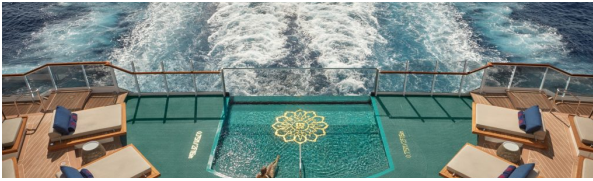

Swirl a glass of amber-coloured Madeira at a café overlooking chequerboard-tiled Praça do Município and prepare to explore lush could forests crisscrossed by hiking trails and black sand beaches below jungle-covered cliffs.



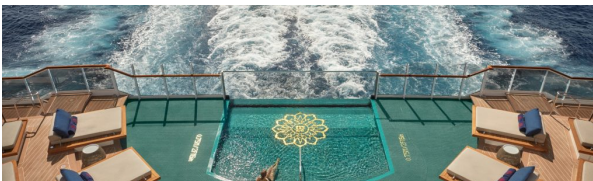

Then, experience the famous toboggan run to Livramento—an exhilarating ride in a wicker traile. At Pico dos Barcelos, bask in the breathtaking sight of Funchal and its surroundings before stopping at Blandy's Wine Lodge to sample a selection of Madeira wines.
